Alternative Housing Site Worker Program

AHS Program Overview

The County of Monterey Emergency Operations Center operates Alternate Housing Sites (AHS) to temporarily house COVID-19 positive and COVID-19 exposed residents who have no place to safely isolate during their designated isolation period. If you meet the eligibility requirements listed below, you can be hired to help with guest services, registration, food distribution, and facilitating maintenance at AHS locations throughout the County, including homeless shelters, Project Roomkey locations, and other service sites, providing an opportunity to serve your community in its time of need as well as a deeply rewarding personal experience. Site worker and COVID-19 safety training will be provided.

WIOA Program Eligibility

- Must be 18 or older with the right to work in the United States
- Males must be registered with Selective Service
- WIOA Adult: you must have low income to qualify for this program
- WIOA Dislocated Worker: you must be laid off or long-term unemployed
- WIOA Youth: you must be out of school and have low income

Terms of Employment for Jobs and Work Experience Opportunities

- \$17.00 per hour, up to 32 hours per week, and up to 26 weeks employment
- Three shifts available: 7:00am-4:00pm; 3:00pm-12:00am; and 11:00pm-8:00am
